The event theme was "Impact," representing the concept that Carl has helped build into the recently approved City Life Certification ministry program.

Youth For Christ asked *The Way of Business* to help design a new ministerial strategy for the current City Life program that, as a result of their work, adds the needed component of a life skills curricula that students can attend while yet in high school.

Carl was invited by YFC to announce the approval of this new program that will begin development later this summer.

Carl concluded with the promise that everyone will realize the positive impact that the new City Life Certification ministry will have on our community and encouraged everyone to do their part in participating in the development and support of this all important ministry. When asked for his thoughts, attendee Sheriff Ozzie Kenezovich stated, "I've been waiting for this for a long time!"

The means for today's youth to become formable parents, professionals and provide positive impact within our churches and community is on the way.

At the age of 77 (when most people are well into retirement), Dick became the founder and minister of Able Ministries, making several trips to Ghana, West Africa. He and his team were responsible for nearly five million decisions for Christ in these "Good News" Centers. It was a privilege on behalf of *The*

Way of Business (TWOB) to meet & be associated with Dick Shanks. He was 90 at the time but still the Owner/Manager of the Able Label Co. Dick & Lil Shanks became the first recipients of TWOB "Well Done Good and Faithful Servant" award taken from Mathew 25. It is presented yearly by TWOB to the Business/Ministry Leader who best incorporates the Economic, Social and Spiritual Capital in

their organizations. Dick Shanks epitomized the values of a man of God, business leader and soul winner for Jesus! Thank you Dick for representing a life well lived. You have received a well deserved and needed eternal rest! Well done good and faithful servant.
